Day 1: Saturday February, 17: Arrival Cairo - Welcome to Egypt

Welcome to Egypt! You'll be met and assisted by a Tour representative at the Cairo airport who will be holding a sign **Mediums Jules and Kelley** and then escorted to your hotel and overnight. (Note: Recommend to arrive latest by 6pm on day 1) **Gathering** dinner at 7PM.

Overnight: Le Meridien Cairo airport Hotel Meals: Dinner



Day 2: Sunday February, 18: Fly to Aswan Aswan Dam and Isis Temple

After breakfast Fly to Aswan and visit **Philae Temple**. It was dedicated to the goddess Isis, the wife of Osiris and mother of Horus. These three characters are very important in ancient Egyptian life, culture and art. Then a visit to The **High Dam and the Egyptian Cotton Shop**. In the afternoon you will lunch aboard a felucca, sailing around Kitchener's Island. Then afterwards depart by motorboat to sightsee on the Nile at the **Botanical Gardens** and then on towards the **Nubian Village.** You will depart the boat and take a camel ride through the desert into the Nubian Village where you will get an opportunity to interact with a Nubian family and learn about their simple life style, culture and traditions.

Overnight: Movenpick Resort & SPA Meals: Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner





Day 3: Monday February, 19: Abu Simbel Temple and Nubian Museum

After breakfast you will depart by bus for **Abu Simbel**. The two temples in the Abu Simbel complex were carved out of the mountainside during the reign of Pharaoh Ramesses II, in the 13th century BCE, as a lasting monument to himself and his queen, Nefertari. After that we head back to Aswan, then the Tour staff will transfer you from the Aswan Movenpick hotel to the **5 Star Luxury Nile cruise ship**. Lunch on board, In the afternoon you will visit the **Nubian Museum**, dedicated to Nubian history, culture and art. After the museum you will have the opportunity to enjoy high tea at a Nubian café and visit the **Healing Oil Shop in Aswan**. Then back to the Cruise.



Overnight: Nile Cruise Ship Meals: Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner All meals are aboard ship

Day 4: Tuesday February, 20: Kom-Ombo and Horus Temples

The ship will set sail. After breakfast you will journey first to **KomOmbo Temple**. The northern half was dedicated to the god Horus and the Southern half to the crocodile god, Sobek. After the tour, you will return to the cruise ship and continue sailing to Edfu. After Lunch enjoy a visit to the **Temple Of Horus** in Edfu. It is one of the best preserved temples in Egypt and was dedicated to the Falconheaded god, Horus. After the tour, we will return to the ship and continue on to Luxor, passing through the Esna Lock. **Overnight: Nile Cruise / Luxor**

Day 5: Wednesday February, 21: Karnak and Luxor Temples

After breakfast you will visit **Karnak Temple**. The temple complex has four parts. The most commonly visited one is the Precinct of Amun-Ra. In addition to this precinct we will visit the three other parts: the Precinct of Mut, the Precinct of Montu, and the ruins of AmenhotepIV. (more commonly known as Ankhenaten.). Then proceed to visit the **Papyrus Shop**. Free time has been built in to enjoy the resort. In the evening (around 6:00 PM) we will visit **Luxor Temple**. This a large ancient temple complex, located on the east bank of the Nile River, and was founded in 1400 BCE. After touring the temple, we will return to the cruise.



Overnight: Nile Cruise / Luxor Meals: Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner

Day 6: Thursday February, 22: Valley of the Kings & Hatshepsut Temple

After breakfast (by 7:30 AM) we will transfer off the Cruise ship, and journey to the **Valley of the Kings**, also called the Valley of the Gates of the Kings. For a period of nearly 500 years, from the 16th tollth century BC, tombs were constructed there for the Pharaohs and powerful nobles of the New Kingdom. The valley stands on the west bank of the Nile, opposite Thebes (modern Luxor), within the heart of the Theban Necropolis. After that we will go to the Ibis Alabaster shop for an opportunity to shop for souvenirs and gifts, followed by a visit to the **Temple of Queen Hatshepsut**. This mortuary temple is dedicated to the sun god Amon-Ra and is located next to the mortuary temple of Mentuhotep II. Afterwards you will visit **the Alabaster Factory**, then lunch. We will return to Luxor and visit **Gohar Shop** for Silver and Gold then check into the Maritim Jolie Ville Luxor





Hotel.

Day 7: Friday February, 23: Dendara Temple

After breakfast you will travel by bus to **Dendara Temple**. It is one of the best-preserved temple complexes in Egypt and contains the Temple of Hathor. Afterwards, we will return to the cruise ship. **Overnight: Luxor / Maritim Jolie Ville Hotel Meals: Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner Meals: All Inclusive Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner**



Day 8: Saturday February, 24: Free Day at the resort

Enjoy your free day. Overnight: Luxor / Maritim Jolie Ville Hotel Meals: Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner





Day 9: Sunday February, 25: Fly to Cairo Egyptian Museum

After breakfast our tour staff will transport you by bus to the Luxor airport, to fly to Cairo. Upon arrival we will visit the **Cairo Egyptian Museum**. This museum contains many important pieces of ancient Egyptian history and houses the world's largest collection of Pharaonic antiquities. This includes many treasures from the tomb of King Tutankhamen. Then we will go to visit the great Alabaster Mosque. Situated on the summit of a centuries-old citadel, this is a fine example of an Ottoman-era mosque. Then transfer to the Mena House hotel and Overnight.

Day 10: Monday February, 26: Memphis / Step Pyramid at Sakkara

After breakfast you will visit **Memphis** and **Saqqara** the Pyramid of Djoser. This step pyramid is the archeological remains of the Saqqara necropolis, situated northwest of the city of Memphis. It was built in 27th century BC during the Third dynasty for the burial of Pharaoh Djoser by his vizier, Imhotep. After lunch we will visit the Serapeum of Saqqara. It was a burial place of the sacred Apis bulls that were incarnations of the ancient Egyptian deity Ptah. It was believed that the bulls became immortal after death as did Osiris. Then back to the hotel.

Overnight: Cairo / Mena House Hotel Meals: Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner





Day 11: Tuesday February, 27: The pyramids and Sphinx

In the early morning there will be an opportunity to have 2 hours of **private time inside the Great Pyramid King's Chamber and Queen's Chamber.**

After breakfast you will visit the last remaining Wonder of the Ancient World--the **Great Pyramids** and the **Sphinx**. After Lunch back to the hotel.

Evening time there will be an opportunity to have **private time** between the paws of the Sphinx.

Dinner and overnight at the hotel.
